



2nd World Mind Sports Games

Draughts – 64

Regulations



1. Time and place.

Tournaments in draughts-64 in the 2nd World Mind Sports Games (IMSA) will be held from 15 to 23 August 2012 in Lille, France, at the Congress Center "Grand Palace" in the room the Jeanne de Flandre # 2.

2. Competition program

The next competitions are held:

1. World Mind Sports Games (WMSG) – World Men Draughts-64 Championship 2012, classic program;
2. World Mind Sports Games (WMSGB) – World Men Draughts-64 Championship 2012, blitz program;
3. World Mind Sports Games (WMSGW) – 1st World Cup in Draughts-64 for women 2012, classic program;
4. World Mind Sports Games (WMSGWB) – 1st World Cup in Draughts-64 for women 2012, blitz program;

Competitions among men are held by the Brazilian version of draughts-64.

Competitions among women are held by the Russian version of draughts-64.

3. Participants

Players are allowed to participate in accordance with the laws of competition and claimed by the national federations.

4. System of competitions and time control

The system of each competition is Swiss in 9 rounds.

All competitions are held by the system of micro-matches consisting of two games:

- ♦ for men – with the draw according to the official tables of FMJD Section-64;
- ♦ for women with the draw of the first move of the white;

The draw is required for both games of the micro-match.

Time control:

Classic program: 45 minutes till the end of the game plus 10 seconds on each move;

Blitz program: 3 minutes till the end of the game plus 3 seconds on each move.

5. Determination of winners

Place in the competition are determined by the maximum amount of points scored by the participants.

For the victory is given - 2 points for a draw - 1, for the defeat - 0.

In the case of a tie score of two or more participants places of participants are defined by the following criteria:

- ♦ the amount of points scored by opponents, without the lowest result (truncated coefficient of Solkoff)
- ♦ the amount of points scored by all opponents (Buchholz coefficient)
- ♦ the amount of points scored by opponents, excluding the 2 lowest results, 3 the lowest results, etc.
- ♦ match up to the first victory with a short time control: 3 minutes till the end of the game plus 3 seconds on each move

6. Special Conditions

- ◆ flag drop fixed only the members of this party;
 - ◆ king is designated by staging one piece on the another;
 - ◆ In case playing with classical time control record of the moves is required by the end of the party.
 - ◆ Terms of draw:
 - If player have in the end of the party three kings against one enemy king and his 15th move (counting from the date of the establishment of the balance of forces) not capture enemy king;
 - If players made 15 moves only kings without moving the simple pieces and not making the capture;
 - If the position in which two players made moves only his kings and the balance of power (ie, there was no taking and no one piece did not become a king) have not changed to 4-and 5-shaped endings - 30 moves;
 - If a player have in the end of the party three kings, two kings and one simple, or one king and two simple against one enemy king, located on the big road, or two kings, one king and one man, or a king against one enemy king, to their 5th move will not be able to achieve a winning position;
 - ◆ Player may offer a draw, if every opponent made at least 20 moves;
- In blitz players may agree to a draw only when number of pieces for each player is 6 or less;
- ◆ Participants are required 5 minutes before the start of the tournament to be in the tournament hall;
 - ◆ Participants, spectators and coaches are required to turn off mobile phones in the playing hall, for calling of mobile phone participant loses in the micro-match and spectators and coaches are removed from the playing hall for one day;
 - ◆ spectators and coaches must observe silence in the playing hall. In case of violation of this paragraph, they are removed from the playing hall for one day;
 - ◆ Protests submitted in writing to the panel of judges, when filing a protest is made bail in the sum of 100 Euro, in the case if the protest meet the deposit is returned;
 - ◆ Participants must be present at the awards ceremony, in case of violation of this paragraph, they are deprived of official awards.

7. Awards

In each competition the top three players will receive a World Mind Sports Games Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals.

In each competition top three players are awarded with diplomas and medals of Section - 64 FMJD. All participants of classic program are awarded with the diplomas of Section - 64 FMJD. In addition the Section 64 FMJD will offer a prize fund €10000.
