On the first item:

Regulations of the World Team Championship 2017, which will be held from August 23 to September 2 in Kranevo (Bulgaria) were discussed and approved. Rapid program was included. The conditions for admission of players have been changed. In all programs for men on the first and second boards will be held the draw of the initial moves and positions according to the approved table (745 positions), on the third board - the draw of the first move of the white. Women on both boards will be play with a draw of the initial moves according to the approved table (150 positions).

On the second item:

Preparations for the World Championship 2017, interaction with sponsors and the media were considered.

On the third item:

The preparation and holding of the World Cup stages in Portugal and Italy in June 2017, financing of these events were discussed.

On the fourth item:

The reports on the holding were heard: Asian Championship among men, women, boys and girls (Tashkent, 16-21.04.2017); European Youth Championship in 6 age groups (Orel, 29.04-08.05.2017) The results were approved.
