The Uganda National Individual Open Brazilian draughts tournament that took place on 7th May 2017 in Giraffe View, Fort Portal was won by Isaac Bafaki from Nakasero DC, followed by Baker Nyanzi from Masaka DC. The last year's champion, Patrick Umala came third. It was a rapid tournament with a time control of 5 minutes and 3 seconds allowed per move. Members were told to mobilize ladies to participate in the national women draughts championship that was postponed to Sunday 21st May 2017. The best female players were going to be trained further in preparation for the upcoming world championship in October in St. Petersburg, Russia. The guest of honour was the Kabarole District Sports Officer, Mrs. Toeistar Tumuhairwe. She was recognized as the first ever female to be on the Executive board of UDF. She pledged to do her level best to promote draughts amongst the ladies. The first five winners got cash prizes.
