International Draughts Federation (IDF) in accordance with the Calendar of the competitions in 2020 together with Georgian United National Draughts Federation holds personal-team European Youth Draughts-64 Championship 2020.

Place, date

Championship will be held at the Sunrise Hotel, 322 David Agmashenebeli str., Kobuleti, Georgia.

Dates: from May 2 (arrival day) to May 10, 2020 (departure day).

Credentials Committee will work May 2 from 16.00 to 22.00. Technical meeting and drawing will be held at 22.30.

Participants who did not pass the Credentials Committee to 22.00 will not be admitted to the competitions.

Participants

Participants are allowed to participate in the competition, who timely filed an application for participation, registered in accordance with this regulation and paid tournament fee. The number of representing the country participants is not limited.

Personal Championship is held separately for boys and girls in six age groups:

Juniors up to 27 years old (1994-2000);

Juniors up to 20 years old (2001-2003);

Cadets up to 17 years old (2004-2006);

Junior cadets up to 13 years old (2007-2009);

Hopes up to 10 years old (2010-2011);

Junior hopes up to 8 years old (2012 and younger).

Boys and girls of younger ages may participate in older age groups (up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 years old), but the organizers do not provide them with accommodation and meals.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the competition, the Code of Ethics.

Participants are obliged to comply with the dress code.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremonies in compliance with the dress code. In case of absence the closing ceremony participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

Tournament regulations

Competitions are held on the official rules of the IDF.

Competitions are personal-team.

Personal competitions are held separately for boys and girls in the three types of program:

Classic game – with time control 40 minutes till the end of the game + 10 seconds per move;

Rapid game – with time control 07 minutes till the end of the game + 05 seconds per move;

Blitz game – with time control 03 minutes till the end of the game + 02 seconds per move.

All programs are held in international (Russian) version of draughts-64 by the system of micro-matches consist of two games.

System of competition (Swiss or round robin) and number of rounds are established by the panel of arbiters depending on the number of participants.

In age groups juniors up to 27 years old and juniors up to 20 years old draw of the moves and positions according to the official table (745 positions) is held for boys and draw of the positions according to the official table (150 positions) is held for girls.

In age groups cadets up to 17 years old and junior cadets up to 13 years old draw of the first move of the white is held for boys and girls. Draw is binding on both games of the micro-match.

In other age groups draw of the moves is not held.

Determination of winners

In personal competitions, the places of participants are determined by the highest total points scored. In case of equality of points for two or more participants, additional criteria are established by the panel of judges in accordance with the rules of the competition.

In each program, winners are determined in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 and 9 years old for boys and girls.

Team's classification is determined in classic program of Championship.

Team results are summarized by the maximum amount of points scored 12 best players (one from age group up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 and 9 years old for boys and girls).

Team's classifications are determined also separately for boys and girls teams by the maximum amounts of points scored 6 best players (by one from age group up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 and 9 years old for boys or for girls).

Awards

Personal Championship:

Cups for the 3 first places in each age group;

Medals for the 3 first places in each age group;

Diplomas for the 3 first places in each age group;

Team's classification:

Cups for the 3 first places in the overall team's classification;

Diplomas for teams and it members in the overall team's classification;

Diplomas for teams and it members in the team's classification among boys and girls.

Personal awards for winners of the personal championship in classic program for all age groups will be announced by organizers at the opening ceremony.

Tournament fees

Tournament fee for each participant is 50 Euro. Tournament fee gives the right to participate in all three programs - classic, blitz and rapid.

The tournament fee for each participant for participation in two programs: blitz and rapid is 30 euros.

Tournament fee must be transferred to the account of the International Draughts Federation no later than April 20, 2020. In an exceptional case, tournament fee may be paid in cash to the credentials committee May 2, 2020. In case of bank transfer payment receipt must be presented to the credentials committee.

Accommodation and meals

Hotel "Sunrise Hotel" is official place for accommodation of participants, coaches and accompanying. Accommodation for all participants, coaches and accompanying persons in an official hotel is required!

Accommodation and meals are provided only to the players of the national federations - members of the International Draughts Federation with no debts to the IDF and promptly applied to participate.

The organizers provide accommodation and three-time meals from May 2 (starting with lunch) to May 10 (ending with breakfast) one player (boy or girl) from each country in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 and 9 years old (6 participants total).

Their travel costs, as well as costs of accommodation, meals and travel of other participants and coaches paid by their sending organizations or by the participants themselves.

Younger players who perform in older age groups are not provided with accommodation and meals.

Participants who provide accommodation and meals by organizers are required to participate in all three programs: classic, rapid and blitz.

For the rest participants, coaches and accompanying costs of accommodation and three-time meals per person per day are:

Accommodation from May 2 (arrival day) to May 10 (departure day) 2020 (total 8 days):

Twin/double occupancy - from 224 euros;

Quadruple accommodation - from 200 euros;

Junior Suite (3 people) - from 240 euros;

Junior Suite (4 people) - from 220 euros;

Single occupancy (number of rooms is limited) - from 280 euros.

Accommodation from May 2 (arrival day) to May 5 (departure day) 2020 (total 3 days) for participants of the blitz and rapid programs and additional days per person per day are:

Twin/double occupancy - from 28 euros;

Quadruple accommodation - from 25 euros;

Single occupancy - from 35 euros.

Travel

You can go to Kobuleti from the airports of Tbilisi, Batumi, Kutaisi and Yerevan by public transport, taxi or by ordering a transfer.
