International Draughts Federation (IDF) in accordance with the Calendar of the competitions in 2021 holds personal-team World Youth Draughts-64 Championship 2021.

Rules & Regulations

Place, date

Championship will be held at the Sports Complex "Aqua Life", Kranevo (Bulgaria), from August 20 (arrival day) till August 31, 2021 (departure day).

Credentials Committee will work August 20, 2021 from 16.00 till 22.00.

Participants

Juniors - boys and girls up to 27 years old (born in 1995-2001);

Juniors - boys and girls up to 20 years old (born in 2002-2004);

Cadets - boys and girls up to 17 years old (born in 2005-2007);

Mini-cadets - boys and girls up to 14 years old (born in 2008-2010);

Hopes - boys and girls up to 11 years old (born in 2011-2012);

Mini-hopes - boys and girls up to 9 years old (born in 2013 and younger).

Younger players can take part in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11 years old.

Offset of the World Championship among students is established in the age groups up to 27 and 20 years old.

Requirements for participants

Players of national federations - members of the International Draughts Federation (IDF) are allowed to participate in the competition.

The International Draughts Federation has the right to invite players from countries that are not IDF members.

Participants of the corresponding age groups are allowed to participate in the competitions who have timely submitted applications for participation, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited.

Participants are required to comply with the Competition Regulations and the Code of Ethics.

Participants are required to comply with the dress code in the playrooms, at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremonies. In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

Competition rules

Competitions are held on the official rules of the IDF.

Competitions are personal-team.

Individual competitions are held separately for boys and girls in three programs: classic, Rapid and Blitz. All programs are held according to the international (Russian) version of draughts-64, according to the system of micro-matches of two games.

The system of holding each competition (Swiss or Robin round) and the number of rounds are established by the panel of arbiters depending on the number of participants.

All programs are held with a draw for the initial moves, which is mandatory in both games of the micro-match:

- juniors-boys up to 20 and 27 years old - draw of moves and positions according to the official table (745 positions);

- juniors-girls up to 20 and 27 years old - draw of moves and positions according to the official table (150 positions);

- cadets (boys and girls) up to 17 years old and mini-cadets (boys, girls) up to 14 years old - draw of the first move of White.

In other age groups, the draw is not held.

Time control:

Classic– 30 minutes till the end of the game + 10 seconds per move;

Rapid – 7 minutes till the end of the game + 3 seconds per move;

Blitz – 3 minutes till the end of the game + 2 seconds per move.

Determination of the winners

In individual competitions, the places of the participants in each age group and each program are determined by the highest total of points scored. In case of equality of points for two or more participants, additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters in accordance with the Competition Regulations.

Team's classification is determined in classic program of Championship.

Team results are summed up according to the highest sum of points scored by the 12 best participants from the country (one participant in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11, 9 years old for boys and girls).

The team results are also summed up separately among for boys and girls teams according to the highest sum of points scored by the 6 best participants (one participant in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11, 9 years old for boys or for girls).

Awards

Cups for the 3 first places in each age group and each program;

Medals for the 3 first places in each age group and each program;

Diploma for the 3 first places in each age group and each program;

Cup for the 1st place in the overall team's classification;

Diploma for the 3 first places in overall team's classification for teams and its members;

Diploma for the 3 first places in team's classification among boys and girls for teams and its members;

Personal awards for winners of Championship for all age groups in classic program

Tournament fees

Tournament fee for each participant:

- 50 euros for participation in three programs - classic, blitz and rapid;

- 30 euros for participation in the classic program;

- 15 euros for each program, for participation in blitz and rapid

Tournament fees must be transferred to the account of the International Draughts Federation no later than August 12, 2021, in an exceptional case, pay in cash to the credentials committee no later than August 20, 2021. In the case of a bank transfer, a receipt of payment must be presented to the credentials committee.

Accommodation and meals

The Sports Complex “Aqua Life” is the official place for the accommodation of participants, coaches and accompanying. In order to ensure the safety of the participants and to comply with the sanitary and hygienic requirements, accommodation with the organizers is obligatory. Booking of accommodation for all participants, coaches and accompanying is held only through the organizer of the competition - the International Draughts Federation (IDF).

The organizers provide accommodation and meals from August 20 (lunch) to August 31 (breakfast) 2021 for 6 participants from each country - a member of the International Draughts Federation (IDF): one boy or girl in age groups up to 27, 20, 17, 14, 11, 9 years old.

Their travel costs, as well as costs of accommodation, meals and travel of other participants, coaches and accompanying pays by their sending organizations.

Younger players performing in older age groups are not provided with accommodation and meals.

Participants, provided with accommodation and meals at the expense of the organizers, are required to participate in all three programs: classic, rapid and blitz.
