On the first item:

All competitions of the IDF calendar for 2018 were held in full and as scheduled.

The 2nd African Championship in Malawi was held successfully and at a high level.

For the first time in Jamaica, the Pan American Championship and the World Cup were held.

For the first time a major international tournament was held in Uzbekistan.

The results of all IDF official competitions 2018 have been approved.

On the second item:

The calendar of the IDF competitions for 2019 was discussed and approved.

The venue for the World Championship among men and women is still being agreed, the dates are September-October 2019.

It was decided to hold the World Youth Team Championship among boys and girls teams from 2019.

The calendar includes new international competitions under the auspices of IDF in Finland, Japan and Barbados.

On the third item:

Regulations of the 2019 World Cup were discussed.

4 stages are included - in Georgia, Italy, Estonia and Portugal.

The issues of summing up and awarding of participants were considered. It was decided that in the 2019 World Cup there will be separate summing up of the results among men and women in three nominations: classic, rapid and blitz. The points scored at all stages will be summed up in the World Cup standings in each nomination.

On the fourth item:

The changes and additions to the IDF Regulations of the official competitions were discussed.

It was decided to hold World Team Championship among teams of countries with 1 team from each country.

Introduced item concerning the World Team Championship among boys and girls teams. Composition of teams: 3 players - one player each in the age groups of cadets, mini-cadets and hopes for boys and for girls.

In team competitions team places are determined by the highest amount of points scored by all team members.

Amount of tournament fees for all competitions was approved.

On the fifth item:

Conditions of the IDF official competition in 2019-2020 were approved.

According to the results of the competition in 2018 and the implementation of norms in the various competitions, new international titles been assigned to the next players:
