On the first item:

The reports on the holding of the European Youth Championship in Bulgaria, the World Cup stages in Georgia and Italy, the Asian Championship among men, women and youth were heard and approved.

For the first time in Helsinki (Finland), together with Rossotrudnichestvo, the International competition "Helsinki-2019" was held. An agreement was reached on long-term cooperation and regular joint events.

On the second item:

The issues of holding the World Draughts-64 Championships among youth, teams and veterans in Kranevo (Bulgaria) from August 22 to September 1, 2019 were discussed. The regulations of world championships have been approved. The international referee Vyacheslav Kuptsov was approved as the Main Arbiter of the World Youth Championship. The international referee Artem Aleshin was approved as the Main Arbiter of the World Championship among teams and veterans (both - Russia). The international referee Alisher Artikov (Uzbekistan) was approved as the Main Arbiter of the World Cup.

On the third item:

The issues of holding the World Championship 2019 among men and women in Sveti Vlas (Bulgaria) were discussed. The prize fund will be at least 30,000 US dollars. The system of holding the World Championship 2019 was discussed and approved taking into account the experience of the World Championship 2017 and the European Championship 2018. The regulations of the championship were approved. The international arbiter Artem Aleshin was approved as the Main Arbiter of the World Championship 2019, the international arbiter Oleg Kholin was approved as the Main secretary (both Russia).

On the fourth item:

The issues of holding competitions in the second half of 2019 were discussed: the World Cup stage in Jõgeva (Estonia) and the World Cup Final in Portugal; competitions in draughts-64 under the auspices of the IDF in the framework of the World Checkers / Draughts Festival in Barbados and the international competitions "Tokyo-2019" which will be held for the first time.
