On the first item:

The reports on the holding of the competitions in Bulgaria from August 20 to August 31, 2021 have been heard:

Personal-team World Youth Championship in 6 age groups

World Youth Team Championship

World Team Championship

World Championship among veterans

World Cup

290 players from 12 countries took part in all competitions.

There was a discussion holding of championships, systems of competitions, conditions for admitting players. The results of competitions were approved.

On the second item:

The report on the holding in Jõgeva (Estonia) of the European Draughts-64 Championship among men and women from 10 to 19 September 2021 was heard. The championship was a qualifier for the 2022 World Championship. The prize fund of the competition was \$ 25,000.

More than 60 players from 13 countries took part in the competition.

The results were approved.

On the third item:

A draughts calendar for 2022 was presented.

Traditionally, a number of competitions will take place in Bulgaria at the end of August:

personal-team and Team World Youth Championship, World Team Championship, World Championship among veterans and World Cup.

The venue of the European Youth Championship has not yet been finally determined. The tournament is scheduled at the end of April. Together with the European Youth Championship, a World Cup is planned.

France applied to host the World Cup, which was canceled in 2021 due to covid restrictions.

The issues of holding the ccontinentals cchampionships, the World Championship and the World Cup in 2022 were discussed.

On the fourth item:

The hosting of the World Cup in Portugal from 20 to 27 November 2021 is not clear due to restrictions on entry to Portugal. Now this issue is being resolved with the Portuguese Draughts Federation.

Due to the pandemic, the World Cup will not take place in Israel in December 2021.

It was decided to summarize the results in the World Cup taking into account the tournaments of 2021 and 2022.
