To all Draughts Federations

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) together with the Uzbekistan Draughts Federation in accordance with the Calendar of the IDF competitions in 2023 holds in Tashkent (Uzbekistan) a number of events in draughts-64:

- 1) Training events
- 2) International competitions "Uzbekistan -2023" - World Cup

1. Venue and dates

Venue: BARAKA Hotel at the address: Shoxdjaxon st. 51, 100100 Tashkent (Uzbekistan).

Dates:

- 1) Training events
From March 25 (arrival day) to April 1 (departure day) 2023
 - 2) International competition "Uzbekistan -2023" - World Cup
From April 1 (arrival day) to April 8 (departure day), 2023
- The credentials committee will work on April 1 from 18.00 to 20.00.

2. Participants

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited. Participants from the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus can only compete under the IDF flag or in a neutral status.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the competition.

Participants are obliged to comply with the dress code.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

3. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according the IDF Game and Competition Rules.

Competitions are personal.

Disciplines: Time controls:

Classic game 30' + 10" for each player until the end of the game.

Break between games is 5 minutes. Recording of moves is obligatory until the end of the game

Rapid 5' + 3" for each player until the end of the game

Blitz 3' + 2" for each player until the end of the game

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF table, obligatory in both games of micro-match.

4. Determination of the winners

In each discipline, places of players are determined by the highest amount of points scored. In case of equality of points for two or more participants, additional criteria are established by the panel of

arbiters in accordance with the regulations of the competition.

In each discipline, winners and prize-winners among men and women are determined.

Additionally, winners and prize-winners are determined among juniors (boys and girls) under 20 years old (born in 2004-2006), boys and girls under 17 years old (born in 2007-2009), boys and girls under 14 years old (born in 2010-2012), boys and girls under 11 years old (born in 2013 and younger).

5. Awards

In each discipline:

Participants who take 1st place among men and women are awarded cups.

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among men and women are awarded with medals and diplomas.

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among juniors (boys and girls) under 20 years old, boys and girls under 17 years old, boys and girls under 14 years old, boys and girls under 11 years old are awarded medals and diplomas.

In the classic program, the winner receives the automatic international title "International Master", participants who took 2nd and 3rd place - the international title "IDF Master".

In blitz and rapid programs, the winners receive the automatic international title of "IDF Master".

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the World Cup 2022-2023 in draughts-64. The points for the places in each competition are summed up.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,000 US dollars.

6. Finances

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

7. Tournament fees

- 60 USD for participation in all three disciplines.

- 25 USD for participation in each discipline.

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration April 1, 2023. Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

8. Accommodation and meals

Reservation of accommodation is through the Uzbekistan Draughts Federation.

Meals are available in cafes near the competition venue.
