To all Draughts Federations

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) together with the Uzbekistan Draughts Federation in accordance with the Calendar of the IDF competitions in 2024 holds in Tashkent (Uzbekistan) World Cup in draughts-64 - International competitions "Uzbekistan -2024".

1. Venue and dates

Venue: Orient Grand Hotel 3* at the address: st. Imama at-Termezi, 44, Tashkent (Uzbekistan).

Dates: from May 11 (arrival day) to May 18 (departure day), 2024.

The Credentials Committee will work on May 11 from 18.00 to 20.00.

2. Participants

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited. Participants from the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus compete in a neutral status.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Rules and Competition Regulations.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Dress Code.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

3. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according the IDF Rules of the Game and Competition Regulations.

Competitions are personal.

Competitions are held according to the international version of draughts-64.

Disciplines: Time controls:

Classic game 30' + 10" for each player until the end of the game.

Break between games is 5 minutes. Recording of moves is obligatory until the end of the game, the recording of the games must be legible

Rapid 5' + 3" for each player until the end of the game

Blitz 3' + 2" for each player until the end of the game

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF table valid as of 01.01.2024, obligatory in both games of micro-match.

4. Determination of the winners

In each discipline, places of players are determined by the highest amount of points scored. In case of equality of points for two or more participants, additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters in accordance with the Competition Regulations.

In each discipline, winners and prize-winners among men and women are determined.

Additionally, winners and prize-winners are determined in the following categories (if there are at least 6 players in the age category):

juniors (boys and girls) under 23 years old (born in 2002-2004)

juniors (boys and girls) under 20 years old (born in 2005-2007)

boys and girls under 17 years old (born in 2008-2010)
boys and girls under 14 years old (born in 2011-2013)
boys and girls under 11 years old (born in 2014 and younger).

5. Awards

In each discipline:

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among men and women are awarded with cups, medals and diplomas.

Participants who take 1st place among juniors U23 (boys and girls), juniors U20 (boys and girls), boys and girls U17, boys and girls U14, boys and girls U11 are awarded cups.

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among juniors U23 (boys and girls), juniors U20 (boys and girls), boys and girls U17, boys and girls U14, boys and girls U11 are awarded medals and diplomas.

In the classic program:

The winner receives the automatic international title "International Master", participants who took 2nd and 3rd place - the international title "IDF Master".

The winner of the open tournament among women receives the automatic international title "Women's IDF Master".

In blitz and rapid programs, the winners receive the automatic international title "IDF Master".

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the World Cup in draughts-64 2024-2025. The points for the places in each competition are summed up.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,100 US dollars.

6. Finances

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

7. Tournament fees

- 60 USD for participation in all three disciplines.

- 25 USD for participation in each discipline.

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration May 11, 2024. Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

8. Accommodation and meals

Reservation of accommodation is through the Uzbekistan Draughts Federation.

Meals are available in cafes near the competition venue.
