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To all Draughts Federations

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) together with The Draughts Association of Ulaanbaatar in accordance with the Calendar of the IDF competitions in 2024 holds in Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia) World Cup in draughts-64 - International competitions " Mongolia-2024".

1. Venue and dates

Venue: Mongolian National University of Education at the address: Baga Toiruu-14, Khoroo 8, Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia 14191.

Dates: from 8th July (arrival day) to 15th July (departure day), 2024.

The Credentials Committee will work on 8th July from 18.00 to 20.00.

2. Participants

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited. Participants from the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus compete in a neutral status.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Rules and Competition Regulations.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Dress Code.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

3. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according the IDF Rules of the Game and Competition Regulations.

Competitions are personal.

Competitions are held in three disciplines: Blitz, Rapid and Classic game.

Blitz and Classic game are played according to the international version of draughts-64.

Rapid is played according to the Brazilian version of draughts-64.

Disciplines:	Time controls:
Classic game	25' + 10" for each player until the end of the game. Break between games is 5 minutes. Recording of moves is obligatory until the end of the game, the recording of the games must be legible
Rapid	7' + 3" for each player until the end of the game
Blitz	3' + 2" for each player until the end of the game

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF table valid as of 01.01.2024.

4. Determination of the winners

In each discipline, places of players are determined by the highest amount of points scored. In case of equality of points for two or more participants, additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters in accordance with the Competition Regulations.

In each discipline, winners and prize-winners among men and women are determined.

Additionally, winners and prize-winners are determined among boys and girls up to 17 years (born in 2008 and younger).

5. Awards

In each discipline:

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among men and women are awarded with cups, medals and diplomas.

Participants who take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among boys and girls up to 17 years are awarded diplomas and souvenirs.

The winners of the disciplines receive international titles.

In the Classic game:

The winner receives the international title "International Master", participants who took 2nd and 3rd place - the international title "IDF Master".

The winner of the open tournament among women receives the international title "Women's IDF Master".

In Blitz and Rapid, the winners receive the international title "IDF Master".

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the World Cup in draughts-64 2024-2025. The points for the places in each discipline are summed up.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,000 Euro.

6. Finances

Expenses for travel, accommodation and meals, tournament fees of participants are paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Draughts Association of Ulaanbaatar and the International Draughts Federation (IDF).

7. Tournament fees

- 60 Euro for participation in all three disciplines.

- 25 Euro for participation in each discipline.

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration 8th July 2024. Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

8. Accommodation and meals

Accommodation of participants is at the "Centaur" Hotel at the address:

Ulaanbaatar, Chingeltei district, 8th quarter, Revolution Road No. 13 / Улаанбаатар хот, ЧИНГЭЛТЭЙ ДҮҮРЭГ, 8-р хороо, Хувьсгалын зам 13 тоот.

Participants, coaches and accompanying persons make accommodation reservations through the Draughts Association of Ulaanbaatar.

Accommodation of participants is in standard double rooms.

The cost of accommodation for one person per day in a double room is 40 Euro.
