**To all Draughts Federations** 

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) in accordance with the Calendar of the competitions in 2024 holds a number of draughts-64 events in Türkiye:

- 1) Educational and training event.
- 2) World Cup in draughts-64 International competitions "Türkiye-2024".

### 1. Venue and dates

Venue: Beach Club Doğanay Hotel 5\*, Alanya

Address: Konaklı Mah. Mustafa Kemal Blv. No:289 Alanya/Antalya (Türkiye).

#### Dates:

- 1) Educational and training event from October 28 (arrival day) to November, 2024.
- 2) World Cup in draughts-64 International competitions "Türkiye-2024" from November 1 (arrival day) to November 9 (departure day), 2024.

The Credentials Committee will work on November 1 from 16.00 to 22.00.

# 2. Participants

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited. Participants from the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus can only compete in a neutral status.

Participants are required to know and comply with the Rules and Regulations of the competition.

Participants are required to comply with the dress code during the competition and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Dress code for competitions: tracksuit or dark trousers and a light shirt for men, trousers and a light blouse or dress for women.

Dress code for the opening and closing ceremonies: dark trousers and a light shirt for men; trousers and a light blouse or dress for women.

Dress code requirements also apply to coaches, representatives and accompanying at competition venues and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

In case of failure to comply with the dress code requirements, players, coaches, representatives and accompanying are not allowed to the competition venues and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

Participants are required to participate in events agreed by the organizers: photo and video shooting, press conferences, meetings with the media, interviews, etc.;

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

### 3. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according the IDF Game and Competition Rules.

Competitions are personal.

Competitions are held in three disciplines:

Blitz, Rapid, Blitz (Brazilian version of draughts-64).

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF tables, obligatory in both games of micro-match.

#### 4. Determination of the winners

Places of players in each competition are determined by the highest amounts of points. In case of equal points of two or more participants the additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters according to the regulations of the competition.

In each competition winners are determined among men, women and juniors (boys and girls) up to 20 years (born in 2005 and younger) if there are at least 5 people in the age group.

#### 5. Awards

In each discipline:

Participants who took  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  place among men and women are awarded cups/awards, official medals and diplomas.

Participants who took  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  place among juniors (boys and girls) up to 20 years are awarded diplomas.

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the World Cup in draughts-64 2024-2025. The points for the places in each competition are summed up.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,100 euros.

### 6. Finances

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

#### 7. Tournament fees

- 60 euro for participation in all three disciplines
- 25 euro for participation in each discipline

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration November 1, 2024.

Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

## 8. Accommodation and meals

The Beach Club Doğanay Hotel 5\* is the official place for the accommodation of participants, coaches and accompanying. Accommodation of all participants, coaches and accompanying persons in the official hotel is obligatory.

Booking of accommodation is held only through the organizer of the competition - the International Draughts Federation (IDF). Participants who have not booked accommodation with the organizers will not be allowed to compete. Players, coaches and accompanying persons receive access to the premises allocated for holding events through the organizer of the competition upon agreed and paid applications.

The host organization responsible for all accommodation issues related to booking and payment for participants is The CHECKIN TURIZM SANAYİ VE TİCARET LİMİTED ŞİRKETİ (Fener mah. Bülent Ecevit bulvarı salih Akar Apt No.19/1 Muratpaşa/Antalya).
