**To all Draughts Federations**

**Dear Sirs!**

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) in accordance with the IDF Calendar of the competitions for 2026 a number of events in draughts-64 in Türkiye:

- 1) Training events
- 2) World Cup - International competitions "Türkiye-2026"

### **1. Venue and dates**

Venue: 5\* Hotel, Kemer region, Antalya (Türkiye)

Dates:

- 1) Training events  
From 15th April (arrival day) to 20th April (departure day) 2026
- 2) World Cup - International competition "Türkiye-2025"
- 3) From 20th April (arrival day) to 29th April (departure day) 2026  
The Credentials Committee will work on 20th April from 18.00 to 22.00.

### **2. Participants**

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the competition.

Participants are obliged to comply with the Dress Code during the competition and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

#### ***Dress Code for competitions:***

- tracksuit, classic suit, dark trousers, plain shirts/polo shirts for men;
- tracksuit, classic suit, trousers, skirts, blouses/shirts/polo shirts or dresses for women.

#### ***Dress Code for the opening and closing ceremonies:***

- classic suit, dark trousers, light plain shirts for men;
- classic suit, trousers, skirts, light plain blouses/shirts or dresses for women.

Dress code requirements also apply to coaches, representatives and accompanying at competition venues and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

In case of failure to comply with the dress code requirements, players, coaches, representatives and accompanying are not allowed into the tournament hall and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

Participants are obliged to participate in events agreed by the organizers: photo and video shooting, press conferences, meetings with the media, interviews, etc.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

### **3. Tournament regulations**

Competitions are held according the IDF Rules of the Game and Competition Regulations.

Competitions are personal.

Competitions are held in three disciplines:

Classic game, Blitz and Rapid.

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF tables valid as of 01.01.2024, obligatory in both games of micro-match.

### **4. Determination of the winners**

Places of players in each competition are determined by the highest amounts of points.

In case of equal points of two or more participants the additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters according to the Competition Regulations.

In each discipline, winners and prize winners are determined among men and women.

Additionally, winners and prize winners are determined among juniors (boys and girls) under 20 (born in 2006 and younger) and among veterans 60 years of age and older (born in 1966 and older), participants must be the required number of years old on the start date of the competition.

### **5. Awards**

In each discipline:

Participants who took 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place among men and women are awarded cups/awards, official medals and diplomas.

Participants who took 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place among juniors (boys and girls) up to 20 years are awarded official medals and diplomas.

Participants who took 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place among veterans 60+ are awarded official medals and diplomas.

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the World Cup in draughts-64 2026.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,400 euros.

### **6. Finances**

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

### **7. Tournament fees**

- 60 euro for participation in all three disciplines

- 25 euro for participation in each discipline

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration 20th April 2026.

Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

### **8. Accommodation and meals**

Accommodation of all participants: players, coaches and accompanying persons in the official hotel where the competition will be held is mandatory. Applications for booking accommodation are accepted only through the organizer - the International Draughts Federation (IDF). Participants who have not booked accommodation with the organizers will not be allowed to compete.

The host organization responsible for all accommodation matters related to room reservations and payment for participants is CHECKIN TURİZM SANAYİ VE TİCARET LİMİTED ŞİRKETİ (Fener mah. Bülent Ecevit bulvarı salih Akar Apt No.19/1 Muratpaşa/Antalya).
