To all Draughts Federations

The International Draughts Federation (IDF) in accordance with the Calendar of the competitions in 2026 holds a number of events in draughts-64 in Türkiye:

- 1) Training events
- 2) World Cup in draughts-64 - International competitions "Türkiye-2026".

1. Venue and dates

Venue: 5* hotel, Manavgat region, Antalya (Türkiye)

Dates:

- 1) Training events
From 25th October (arrival day) to 1st November (departure day) 2026
- 2) World Cup in draughts-64 - International competitions "Türkiye-2026"
from 1st November (arrival day) to 11th November (departure day), 2026
The Credentials Committee will work on 1st November from 16.00 to 22.00.

2. Participants

All participants regardless of gender, age and rating are allowed to participate in the competitions, who have submitted an application for participation in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee. The number of participants representing a country is not limited.

Participants are required to know and comply with the Rules and Regulations of the competition. Participants are required to comply with the dress code during the competition and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Dress code for competitions

- tracksuit, classic suit; dark trousers, plain light-coloured shirts/polo shirts for boys;
- tracksuit, classic suit, trousers, long plain skirts, plain light-coloured shirts/polo shirts, blouses or dresses for girls;
- not allowed: T-shirts, shorts, sweatpants (separate from the tracksuit), multi-coloured shirts, slippers, flip-flops, sneakers.

Dress code for the opening and closing ceremonies:

- classic suit, dark trousers, plain light-coloured shirts for boys;
- classic suit, trousers, long plain skirts, plain light-coloured shirts/blouses or dresses for girls;

The final decision on whether a participant complies with the established dress code is made by the panel of arbiters.

Dress code requirements also apply to coaches, representatives and accompanying at competition venues and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

In case of failure to comply with the dress code requirements, players, coaches, representatives and accompanying are not allowed to the competition venues and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

Participants are required to participate in events agreed by the organizers: photo and video shooting, press conferences, meetings with the media, interviews, etc.;

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

3. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according to the IDF Game and Competition Rules.

Competitions are personal.

Competitions are held in three disciplines:

Classic, Blitz (international/Russian version of draughts-64)

Rapid (Brazilian version of draughts-64).

In all disciplines, open tournaments are held according to the Swiss system in 7-9 rounds by the system of micro-matches from two games with a draw of initial moves and positions according to the official IDF tables, obligatory in both games of micro-match.

4. Determination of the winners

Places of players in each competition are determined by the highest amounts of points. In case of equal points of two or more participants the additional criteria are established by the panel of arbiters according to the Competition Rules.

In each competition winners are determined among men, women and juniors (boys and girls) up to 20 years (born in 2007 and younger) if there are at least 5 people in the age group.

5. Awards

In each discipline:

Participants who took 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among men and women are awarded cups/awards, official medals and diplomas.

Participants who took 1st, 2nd and 3rd place among juniors (boys and girls) up to 20 years are awarded diplomas.

Participants of the World Cup get points in the overall standing of the World Cup in accordance with the Regulations of the 2026 World Cup in draughts-64.

The prize fund of the competition will be at least 2,400 euros.

6. Finances

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

7. Tournament fees

- 60 euro for participation in all three disciplines

- 25 euro for participation in each discipline

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration 1st November 2026.

Participants who have not paid the tournament fee before the end of registration will not be allowed to compete.

8. Accommodation and meals

Accommodation of all participants: players, coaches and accompanying persons is mandatory in the official hotel where the competition will be held. Applications for booking accommodation are accepted only through the organizer - the International Draughts Federation (IDF). Participants who have not booked accommodation with the organizers will not be admitted to the competition.

Players, coaches and accompanying persons are granted access to the premises allocated for the competitions through the organizer upon agreed and paid applications.

The host organization which deals with accommodation and all matters related to the reservation and payment for the accommodation of players, coaches and accompanying persons, is the organization CHECKIN TURIZM SANAYİ VE TİCARET LİMİTED ŞİRKETİ (Fener mah. Bülent Ecevit bulvarı salih Akar Apt No.19/1 Muratpaşa/Antalya).
