To all Draughts Federations

The International Draughts Federation (IDF), in accordance with the Calendar of the competitions in 2026, holds in Türkiye the World Youth Team Draughts-64 Championship teams during the World Youth Draughts-64 Championship.

1. Venue and dates

Venue: 5* hotel, Manavgat region, Antalya (Türkiye)

Dates: 4th November 2026.

The Credentials Committee will work on 3rd November from 16.00 to 22.00.

2. Participants

One team of boys and one team of girls from each national federation-member of the International Draughts Federation (IDF) are allowed to participate in the competition.

Each team consists of 3 main players and 3 reserve players, with 1 player each in the main list and 1 reserve player each in the age groups:

under 17 (born in 2010 and younger), under 14 (born in 2013 and younger), under 11 (born in 2016 and younger).

Girls can play in the boys' team.

A younger participant has the right to play on any board of an older age group.

3. Requirements for participants

Teams are allowed to participate in the competition upon application from national federations, having submitted an application in a timely manner, registered on time and paid the tournament fee.

Participants are required to comply with the Rules, Competition Regulations and Dress Code during the competition and at the opening and closing ceremonies.

Participants must be present at the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.

In case of absence the closing ceremony, participants lose all official awards. Awards will not be sent or transferred.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.

4. Tournament regulations

Competitions are held according to the IDF Game and Competition Rules.

The competitions are held according to the International/Russian version of draughts-64 by the system of micro-match from two games with a time control of 3'+2" for each participant until the end of the game.

In the age groups of boys and girls under 14 and 17 years old, the draw of the first move of white is applied; in the age group of boys and girls under 11 years old, the draw of moves is not applied.

Competition system: Swiss or round robin system is established by the panel of arbiters depending on the number of participating teams.

5. Determination of the winners

The places of the teams are determined by the highest amounts of points scored by all team members. In case of equal points scored by two or more teams, the places of the teams are determined in accordance with the official IDF Rules of the Game and Competition.

6. Awards

Teams that take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place are awarded cups/awards and official diplomas, team members are awarded official medals and diplomas.

7. Finances

All costs of participants paid by sending organizations or themselves.

The costs for organizing the competition and paid by the Organizing Committee.

7.1. Tournament fees

The tournament fee for each team is 30 Euros and 10 Euros for each reserve player.

Tournament fees must be paid in cash on the day of registration on 3rd November 2026. Teams that have not paid the tournament fee by the end of registration will not be admitted to the competition.

7.2. Accommodation and meals

Accommodation of all participants: players, coaches and accompanying persons is mandatory in the official hotel where the competition will be held. Applications for booking accommodation are accepted only through the organizer - the International Draughts Federation (IDF). Participants who have not booked accommodation with the organizers will not be admitted to the competition. Players, coaches and accompanying persons are granted access to the premises allocated for the competitions through the organizer upon agreed and paid applications.

The host organization which deals with accommodation and all matters related to the reservation and payment for the accommodation of players, coaches and accompanying persons, is the organization CHECKIN TURIZM SANAYİ VE TİCARET LİMİTED ŞİRKETİ (Fener mah. Bülent Ecevit bulvarı salih Akar Apt No.19/1 Muratpaşa/Antalya).
